MINUTES

1. **To receive any declarations of interest**- None
2. **To receive apologies**- Mr J Little, Mr J Haugh, Mr N Jackson and County & District Cllr Robinson
3. **To discuss the Tour of Britain cycle event**

The event had been discussed at the last village hall committee meeting and it was agreed that it can be used to the advantage of the village. Lots of people will be involved over the next 4 weeks until the event takes place. Yellow bikes are appearing all over the place. A councillor asked if many people will be coming to the village to watch the race. It was agreed that Kirkoswald is quite a key point. Mrs K Raine said that there will be refreshments served in the village hall and councillors considered whether the Square outside could be cleared for use. It was noted that grants of £500 are available for the parish and it was agreed that the village hall committee apply for a grant to fund a large screen to show the 2 hours of live coverage and food. It was noted that the pubs are to do meals. It was agreed to source bunting for the square. The school are going onto the field above the school to watch it. Several councillors agreed to look at various fields for additional parking (it was noted that these would have to be checked on the day to ensure that they are still suitable). It was agreed that extra bins will be needed and volunteer litter pickers will be needed on the Thursday night to help clear up. Volunteers will also be needed to serve refreshments as some committee members will be at work. It was agreed that the Clerk submit a piece to the Herald with details of the day's events. Mrs S Quinn thanked Mrs K Raine and Jean for coming along to the meeting.
4. **To discuss the footpath towards Eden Bridge**- Mrs S Quinn reported that she had had a reply from Charles Baker confirming receipt of her email but there is no further information as yet. Councillors discussed whether to look into grant information and quotes at this point. After discussion it was agreed to wait to avoid causing offence. It was noted that there can be a delay between applying for the grant money and beginning work and it was agreed that in the scheme of this project another

month is not a problem. It was noted that the highway and footpath projects are linked. Mrs S Quinn said that she had spoken to John Banks (Highways) and the drainage work is being done as the parish council are looking to do the footpath. It was agreed to wait before applying for grants and obtaining quotes (proposed by Mr R Cranston, seconded by Mr J R Raine, unanimous vote).

5. **To consider any planning applications made and related matters**- Viol Moor- Mrs S Quinn reported that everything has now been done to comply with planning regulations and it was agreed to remove it from the agenda.
